In continuation to this Ministry's Letter of Intent of even number dated 30th June 2009 and with reference to your letter dated 3rd July 2009, I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Government for establishment of new medical college at Ahmedabad, Gujarat by A.M.C. Medical Education Trust, Ahmedabad, Gujarat with an annual intake of 150 (One Hundred and Fifty only) students with prospective effect i.e. from the academic year 2009-10 under Section 10(A) of IMC Act, 1956, as amended.

This permission of the Central Govt. for establishment of new medical college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievement of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India. The college shall not admit more than one batch of students against this letter of permission. The college shall also apply to Medical Council of India for renewal of permission well before the commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievement in terms of infrastructure, etc. and equipment as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as required by Medical Council of India norms must be clearly indicated. The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Government.



Subject: Reservation for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) for admission in Medical Education Institutions under Constitution Amendment (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019 dated 12.01.2019. Increase of MBBS seats under EWS Quota for the academic year 2019-20. Reg.

Madam/Sir,

In continuation to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 30.06.2019 increasing twenty (20) additional MBBS seats in 08 GMERS Medical Colleges, 02 Municipal Corporation Medical Colleges and 02 Medical Colleges in PPP mode on the BoG/MCI's recommendation dated 29.06.2019, I am directed to say that BoG/MCI vide its letter dated 18.07.2019 (copy enclosed) has now informed the Ministry that they have revised their recommendation to 50 more MBBS seats in each of the 08 GMERS Medical Colleges, 02 Municipal Corporation Medical Colleges and 02 Medical Colleges in PPP mode and requested the Ministry to approve the proposal. After careful consideration of the BoG/MCI's proposal dated 18.07.2019, Ministry accepted the BoG's request to increase 30 additional MBBS seats in the said 12 Medical Colleges and inform the State Government that increased MBBS seats in the 12 aforementioned Medical Colleges may be read as under:-

NOTIFICATION

S.O.... In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of the section 11 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956), the Central Government, after consulting the Medical Council of India, hereby makes the following further amendments in the First Schedule to the said Act.

a) In the said First Schedule against "Gujarat University, Gujarat" and under the heading 'Recognised Medical Qualification' [hereinafter referred to as column (2)], after the last entry and entry relating thereto under the heading 'Abbreviation for Registration' [hereinafter referred to as column (3)], the following shall be inserted, namely:-

"Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery"

MBBS

(This shall be a recognised medical qualification when granted by Gujarat University, Gujarat in respect of students being trained at Ahmadabad Municipal Corporation Medical Education Trust Medical College, Ahmadabad with annual intake of 150 MBBS students on or after January, 2014.

- Note to all:
1. The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
 2. The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.
 3. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute/medical college.
